Dear Stanford University Golf Course Members and Constituents:

With the ever-changing landscape of state and county health mandates, as it relates to Covid-19, I am writing to share the latest updates as they pertain to the Stanford Golf Course and Golf Learning Center.

As of Monday, with the easing of the California regional stay at home order, we have now shifted back to oversight by Santa Clara County. Their updated directives for outdoor activity were issued last night. [Please click here to read the directive:](#)

Based on these directives here are the impacts on our golf operations moving forward:

1. We will now require masks at ALL TIMES both on the course while playing and at the learning center while practicing. Our current stipulations on social distancing and masking in and around all parking lots, clubhouse, and golf shop areas remain in place.
2. Groups of up to three households will be allowed on the course effective immediately.
3. Three golf carts will be sold to groups of three households, if so desired, to maintain single household ridership.
4. 3 day advance booking for all other constituents will remain in place.
5. Existing tee times which are booked through this Sunday will remain in place. Users are allowed to add additional people to their current booking as long as the three household stipulation is followed.

Thanks again for your patience through all of this. Our staff remains committed to offering a fun, healthy, and safe experience for all Stanford Golf Course users.
